THE ACTIVITIES BEGIN ON CHRISTMAS DAY

Challenge yourself and try new things at GT Extreme, one of the 5 different programme zones at Red Rose 2010. We sent reporters Emma Parker and Josh Holmes to capture the day and find out your highlights.

Following Blencathra Sub Camp around GT Extreme was quite a challenge with 5 sub zones spread across the site. Blencathra took part in everything the day had to offer particularly the Adrenalin Zone which certainly gets the energy pumping as crowds of participants took on the high ropes.

A group of Guides from Ireland took on the challenge of the Jacob's Ladder, nervous banter filled the air as the girls prepared themselves. As the activity began any concern was soon lost as the team of 12 worked together to complete the challenge. Team work is the only way to complete this test of fitness and nerves. Lucy, 12, from Ireland told us *"It's brilliant. It's fun because everyone has to work together to complete it. I was scared to begin with, but I trust my friends."* Nearby a group of Catalonian and Scottish Scouts were busy completing 'High All Aboard' climbing in groups of four up a narrow pole to a small platform on the top, where dare-devil tasks were undertaken. On the 'Leap of Faith' participants nerves were put to the test above the bustling camp centre. Sam, 13 from the UK explained *"It doesn't look easy and I was nervous, but it wasn't as bad as I thought. I really enjoyed it"*.

Across site the Adventure Zone offers the opportunity for participants to test their aim, with the archery challenge. With energetic instructors and the wearing of a selection of interesting hats this zone definitely offers the fun factor. Callum, 14 from the UK explained *"It's worth having a go. We got to wear funny hats like Viking, Indians and Australians. It was great fun I manage to burst two balloons, one of them had been missed by all of my friends"* Nearby Rockets and Bubbles flew across the sky, and Volcanoes erupted along with the laughter of the participants taking part in the Discovery Zone. The Skill Zone takes you back to the basics with the opportunity to test your Scouting Skills. With Fire lighting and axe and saw activities running alongside the chance to become the next Jamie Oliver by testing your Backwoods cooking knowledge.

Gaining a new understanding and learning more about yourself and the world around you is the aim of the Global Zone. Activities are being run by representatives from The Red Cross, Shelter Box and The Jane Goodall Institute. Role play and games allow participants to explore issues close to home no matter where you're from. With the five Sub Zones full of opportunity and adventure GT Extreme is definitely something not to miss.

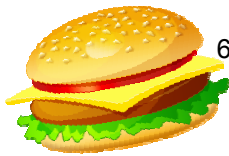


Weather Forecast
